### General:

- Only the Canadian Amateur DanceSport Association (CADA) has jurisdiction over these Championships.
- No phone entry is accepted. Entry for competition must be received on or before March 10, 2006 together with payment for Ticket Form. See : TICKET ORDER FORM.
- There is a \$25.00 late entry fee for entries sent after deadline March 10, 2006.
- Schedule will be posted on the OADA web page [www.ontariodancesport.com](http://www.ontariodancesport.com) after April 9, 2006.
- All of these Canadian Closed Championships will be conducted according to the CADA Championship Rules. It is each entrant's responsibility to learn and fully comply with these Rules. Ignorance of these Rules will not be accepted as an excuse. The CADA Championship Rules are available at: [www.dancesport.ca/cada/rules.html](http://www.dancesport.ca/cada/rules.html)
- In ALL Canadian Closed Championships one member of the couple must be a Canadian Citizen as of the day of the competition and the other must comply to Rule 7.4 of CADA Schedule B. All competitors must present their valid Regional Assoc. membership card including proof of CRAD registration when obtaining competition numbers and must also be fully prepared at all times to present satisfactory proof of citizenship and age, preferable picture ID such as a passport or citizenship card. CADA and the organizer reserve the right to require such proofs to their satisfaction at any time on the day of the Championships, as a condition of competing or receiving presentations. Competitors are strongly advised to bring originals plus full photocopies for registration officials.
- Competitors under 18 years of age MUST have this release signed by a parent or legal guardian.
- In all championships a minimum of three (3) couples is required to hold the championship.
- All Championship competitors MUST complete the "ANTI-DOPING" form and return it with this form.
- Competition dress is obligatory for all Championships. See: [www.dancesport.ca/cada/rules.html](http://www.dancesport.ca/cada/rules.html)  
Standard - Men: Black or dark blue tails, white shirt and white tie. Standard - Ladies: Competition dress.  
Latin - Men: Latin costume with sleeves Latin - Ladies: Latin costume for ladies.
- No responsibility can be accepted by CADA or OADA for the loss or theft of articles left in changing rooms, the ballroom or hotel. Neither can they be held liable for any injury sustained by persons attending or participating as competitors, spectators, exhibitors or in any other capacity. Everyone attends at their own risk.
