- No phone entry is accepted. Entry for competition must be received on or before March 10, 2006 together with payment for Ticket Form. See : TICKET ORDER FORM.
- Events will not be held with less than three (3) couples. Late entries will not be accepted if it requires an extra round or trophy.
- There is a \$25.00 late entry fee for entries sent after deadline March 10, 2006.
- Each couple is allowed to compete at their registered minimum level (eg. Bronze) and one level above the registered minimum (eg. Silver).
- Each couple is allowed 1 free entry. Additional entries will be charged \$10.00 per couple per entry.
- Youth couples may compete in Adult categories.
- Senior couples may compete in Adult categories.
- Exact start times subject to change without notice. Competitors must be ready to go onto the floor one hour before the scheduled start time.
- Schedule will be posted on the OADA web page www.ontariodancesport.com after April 9, 2006.
- No responsibility can be accepted by CADA or OADA for the loss or theft of articles left in changing rooms, the ballroom or hotel.
